You will be asked to present your impressions in a few slides during the BSUGIS session of the BSW 2024.

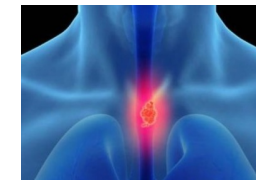
